S D S GOLDEN BOY stalked the early leader three wide, sustained a bid to gain command into the stretch and drew clear. ROBYN LANE was within striking distance early, rallied four wide to gain the place but was unable to catch the winner. TEF'S WHATASTAR showed early speed along the inside and came up empty in the stretch but held the show. PASSEM PRO was unhurried early, went five wide in the stretch and placed a mild bid. COW PUNCHIN CASEY was off slow early, went five wide and sustained a mild effort in the stretch. ABO TRICK raced mid pack while saving ground then gave way. W F WILDCAT was outrun early, went four wide and was not a factor. ON FIFTH STREET was unhurried early, went three wide and was not a threat.
