CELLARS GRANGE was unhurried early, placed a bid slipping thru along the rail, surged quickly clear and held well. WRED N RUNNIN was outrun early racing well behind the field, rallied circling the field and closed fast three wide late. NOTIME TO BADINAGE was wide into the first turn, placed a brief bid nearing the eighth pole then weakened, but held the show. HAP HAP was close in the early going racing between foes then faded. MIXED BERRIES was away alertly to set the early pace racing well off the rail then gave way. PRINCE LOGAN chased the early leader and was finished after a half.
