KEAGAN'S WAY was outrun early, closed the gap into the second turn, went four wide between rivals into the stretch, dug in and inched away to prove best. DEVON'S IRON GIANT was allowed to settle early four wide, drifted out seven wide into the stretch and didn't have enough late. CAT'S DOMAIN set the early pace racing off the inside, tired into the stretch and weakened. FLY SO SILENT was well back in the early going, went three wide and placed a mild bid into the stretch. KASHA ROO stalked the early leaders five wide, contested the pacesetter down the backstretch then came up empty in the lane. SUNNY HOPE failed to threaten and was eased to the wire. VINCE CARTER showed brief speed racing three wide then faded and was eased.
