Footnotes

RUN LITTLE RED prompted the early pace from the outside, placed a bid into the stretch, dug in and edged clear. JACKPOT MAGIC was unhurried early, gained ground down the backstretch, was fanned six wide into the stretch and closed with urging to get up for the place. PURE TERA was forwardly placed early saving ground, angled out three wide to place a bid and was outfinished for the place. PENALTY BOX set the early pace drawing clear while saving ground then weakened in the drive. MR. PLAY MISTY was outrun early, went four wide and placed a mild bid. TWOSTEPPIN' ERIC was allowed to settle early, went seven wide at the three sixteenth and lacked a rally. MISTER LANE was within striking distance early along the rail then faded steadily. DOUBLE RECESS was well back early, never a threat, then was pulled up near the seven sixteenth and vanned off.
