JIM WADE set the early pace from the inside, drew clear, held to nearing the eighth pole then tired and gave way. WANAWIN raced mid pack saving ground, sustained a brief bid then flattened. B R SANDSTORM was forwardly placed early between foes and lacked a late effort. SWEEP N HOME forced the early pace from the outside and was finished after a half. LOUIE'S BROTHER made a move mid way then faded. EL CARDENAL showed little in a dull effort. SILVER DEVIL R F was within striking distance early then tired and retreated.
