Footnotes

HE'S A FLYER was within striking distance early, rallied four wide into the turn, moved up steadily to be on even terms with BOURBON CAT nearing the sixteenth pole, then dug in and inched away. BOURBON CAT forced the early pace along the inside, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole, was challenged near the sixteenth pole and outfinished. AUTOMOBILE was off slow early racing four wide, angled between foes in the turn, drifted out six wide in the stretch and was along for the show. SERVICE TIME showed early speed racing off the rail, was challenged into the stretch then gave way. EL TROFEO (ARG) was unhurried early, raced wide and lacked a rally. RUN RILEY RUN was outrun early, went three wide and showed little. PACHE ECHO STAR chased the early leaders racing off the inside then retreated steadily after the first quarter.
