### Footnotes

SUZI'S CASE was never far back early, circled the field seven wide, placed a bid then wore down her foes through the stretch and drew clear. A PENNY LANE dueled from between rivals, edged clear into the stretch but was outfinished by closing rival. STORMIN BOMB dueled from between rivals, weakened into the turn then came back in the stretch and gained the show. CLOUD dueled five wide then tired and flattened in the drive. KNOW WHEN TO RUN dueled from off the inside, gained a short lead into the turn then tired and gave way. R F FLYNBAYAKOA was off slow early saving ground and lacked a late effort. BO'S SECRET RUCKUS was void of early speed while saving ground and was not a threat. COCO ROSIE went six wide and retreated steadily.
