TRACK TALK drew quickly clear angling in to save some ground, held a safe advantage and was kept to task to the wire. BOLIVAR SHAG tracked the early leader from along the inside, was no match and followed the winner through the stretch. A CLEVER DOME was allowed to settle early while saving ground, placed a mild effort and was along for the show. PROBY was off slow early, went four wide in the stretch with a late effort. MILLER WHO chased the early leader from the outside, drifted out through the stretch and weakened. WIN'N SPURS raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a rally. DEVON'S PRINCE was outrun early racing off the inside and lacked a bid. SQUIDDLE SKIRT raced wide and was not a factor. HOMELESS dropped back, was taken up and vanned off.
