SAFEWAY DAN pressed the early pace from between rivals, lost ground into the turn, came back in the stretch three wide and surged clear late. ZEBBA was off slow early racing four wide, circled the field six wide and closed late to gain the place. FOUND A PENNY forced the early pace along the rail, gained a short lead into the turn, held to mid stretch then flattened. TOM ES LA BULLY was outrun early saving ground, drifted out two wide near the eighth pole and showed some effort late. SOARING BEEGEE was unhurried early racing along the inside and lacked a gain late. KARENS PRIZE set a pressured early pace three wide and was finished early. CHA CHA CHIMES was void of early speed, raced wide and was not a threat. KATIE'S TIZZY raced mid pack five wide then gave way. WORLD GENIUS was forwardly placed three wide, drifted out wide in the stretch and retreated.
