QUIET AGAIN prompted the early pace four wide, settled down the backstretch, made a bold move nearing the five sixteenth, took command then drew out. HEZAMAZING set the early pace while saving ground, drew clear down the backstretch, was challenged into the second turn and didn't have enough late. DUNSCOMBE was outrun early racing off the inside, rallied into the stretch angling along the rail and showed some effort late. REGATTA TONE was unhurried early saving ground, angled four wide near the three sixteenths and lacked a gain late. SUMMERTIME SAL was off slow early while saving ground, angled five wide and passed a tiring foe in the stretch. FULLOFENERGY stalked the early leader racing off the rail then gave way.
