Footnotes

APTITUDE bumped three deep into the first turn, angled in unhurried, moved up inside on the second turn, swung out for the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. TRIBUNAL was well placed off the rail, angled in some on the backstretch, swung out three deep with a bid into the stretch, gained command near midstretch and drifted in some, kicked clear but was caught late. HOOVER TOWER forced the pace outside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, steadied behind the runner up in midstretch and weakened but held third. CYBER PATROL pulled his way to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. L. A. ALBERT bumped and steadied sharply between horses into the first turn, angled in and saved ground, came out a bit for the stretch and improved position. CAPOTE SUN angled in and stalked the early pace three deep then between foes midway on the backstretch, continued off the rail, drifted five wide into the stretch and weakened. HONEST RIDGE bumped and took up in tight quarters inside into the first turn, came out leaving that bend, went three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. TIMBER YIELD bobbed at the start, went four wide into the first turn, moved up four wide on the backstretch, dropped back some into the second turn and weakened. RADIX ALIS pulled his way along five wide into the first turn, continued outside on the backstretch, split rivals into the stretch and failed to menace. A claim of foul by the rider of HOOVER TOWER against the runner-up for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
