TEAKABU unhurried toward the inside to the second turn, came out on that bend, swung six wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to prove best. VERY RACY angled in and saved ground nearing the first turn, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, also rallied under some urging but could not quite match the winner. EXTRA FANCY four wide approaching the first turn, was forced wider into that turn, angled in on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, moved up into the stretch, was in tight in deep stretch, then steadied and was forced out sharply approaching the wire. GIN RUNNING saved ground stalking the pace, bid outside the pacesetter into the stretch and gained a short lead, inched away in midstretch, then ducked into the inner rail under the right handed whip and hopped for several jumps in deep stretch to lose her position and action. COINER sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside into the stretch, then weakened but was taken up sharply in tight in deep stretch. OPEN ENDED stalked the early pace between horses then outside a rival, came out four wide leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and weakened. CRAFTIQUE off a bit slowly, went up outside the early leader into the first turn, stalked that one off the rail, drifted out and dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and had little left. LIL'OCANEPA drifted out into the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry, GIN RUNNING was disqualified and placed fifth for interference in late stretch.
