IN SUMMATION chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and inched away late under a crack of the whip and good handling. MACHISMO had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back inside rivals, could not quite match the winner late but was clearly second best. BLACK SEVENTEEN a step slow to begin, was between horses early then dueled three deep, stalked on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, put a head in front between rivals in midstretch and weakened late. JOHNNY EVES dueled between horses on the backstretch, fell back some and angled in to stalk on the turn, gave way in the stretch and was eased in the final furlong.
