**Footnotes**

PINSTRIP KID four wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, moved up inside on the second turn, swung out leaving that turn and into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead in deep stretch and proved best. JOE CARL stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, took the lead, inched away in midstretch, drifted in, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and was outfinished. ALABAMA BOY settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, angled out off heels in upper stretch and bested the others. GREEN CARD JAMES a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival, split horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. AQUICKSTING took the early lead and set the pace off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, was between foes into the stretch and weakened. RINGOLEVIO pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. PANDA stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. EGYPT (GB) broke a bit slowly, stalked three deep then off the rail, fell back in the stretch and gave way.
