Footnotes

MONA STORM stalked the pacesetter on the outside down the backstretch, moved closer on the turn, bid for the lead and inched clear at the top of the lane and held all foes safe to the wire. FIVE SILVER STARS chased the pace off the rail or outside a rival down the backstretch, went into the turn between horses, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and rallied late to gain the place. RUSSIAN RIVER a bit slow into stride, angled outside down the backstretch, was caught four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied through the lane, could not get to the winner and lost second late. BUTCH MARINO stalked the pace on the rail down the backstretch and around the turn,angled off the rail in midstretch and was between horses in the late stages while being outfinished for a minor award. FILLY POWER was hustled out of the gate to make the early lead, maintained the advantage to the top of the lane when overtaken and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. REAL HOUSEWIFE stalked off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch off the rail and weakened between foes in the final furlong. YOU CAN DREAM chased on the inside down the backstretch, came off the rail around the turn, was asked for her best nearing the quarter pole, drifted out in the lane and did not offer a rally.
