MACIAS pulled his way along to duel three deep, angled in and inched away on the hill and drew clear in the lane under a brisk hand ride while being shown the whip. MY SUMMER SLEW stalked outside, drifted four wide into the stretch, angled in some and edged foes for the place. MUNY stalked just off the inside, came out leaving the hill, was fanned five wide into the stretch and split rivals late for the show. RED SHARP HUMOR was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the hill, was fanned six wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. STRIKING SPIRIT (GB) settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COFFEE BOY duelled between horses, steadied in tight on the hill, stalked inside leaving the hill and weakened. EL ADELANTADO prompted the pace inside, also steadied in tight on the hill, stalked into the stretch, came out off heels in deep stretch and lacked the needed late response. Claims of foul by the riders of EL ADELANTADO and COFFEE BOY against the winner for alleged interference on the hill were not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
