Footnotes

JOE CARL unhurried along the inside to the second turn, moved up along the rail then came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging while drifting in and got up nearing the wire. SCORPION TIME saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside to gain the lead leaving the second turn and into the stretch, kicked clear and held on well but was caught late. HONOUR THE DEPUTY chased outside a rival, went up three deep then bid four wide a quarter mile out, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. ANABAA PREMIUM three wide early, stalked outside a rival, split horses three deep with a bid leaving the second turn to briefly put a head in front, angled in between foes into the stretch and weakened. CLINTON had good early speed and inched away on the first turn, set the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses a quarter mile out and weakened in the drive. UNEXPECTED GIFT between horses early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
