Footnotes

BEAUTIFUL NOISE stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under left handed urging. DRAWING A BLANK forced the pace outside a rival, took a short advantage into the stretch, fought back inside the winner while drifting in some past midstretch, could not match that one but held second. SENSE OF DIVINITY sped to the early lead, dueled inside the runner-up, fought back when initially headed, could not match strides with either of the top pair late, came out in deep stretch and clearly bested the others. SQUALL LINDA settled three deep early then outside a rival on the backstretch, came out some into the stretch and lacked a rally. REIGN ON RAINIER angled in on the first turn and saved ground off the pace, came out around a foe on the second turn and failed to menace. MEDITATIVE saved ground in midpack early, continued inside, dropped back on the backstretch and gave way. MYTHICAL MIRAGE off a bit awkwardly, was rank toward the inside after being roused in the early stages, came well off the rail on the backstretch and was outrun.
