Footnotes

ECSTATIC had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between horses down the hill and into the stretch, continued gamely through the drive and proved best under a strong hand ride. OUR NEW RECRUIT sped to a slim early lead, angled in and dueled inside, fought back through a stiff drive and continued willingly to the wire. EL CIELO hopped in the air to be off slowly, moved up inside on the hill, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch, could not catch the top pair but outfinished a rival for third. JENTZEN pulled early, cut the corner at the right hand curve, tugged ins way up to bid three deep on the hill and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. WITH IRIS bobbled at the start, stalked the pace between foes then outside a rival, angled in crossing the dirt and had little left in the stretch.
