VICTORINA chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, waited off heels leaving the second turn, split rivals into the stretch, came out in the drive and rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and won clear. YOU LIFT ME UP stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn, gained the lead leaving that turn, inched clear and drifted inward in the stretch and held second. ISLAND HOP settled off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, also drifted in some and was edged for the place. DOUBLE TROUBLE (BRZ) pulled her way along and steadied into the first turn, chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. FOREST MELODY bobbed at the start, stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival and dueled for the lead, battled between horses on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. CHOCOLATE LAVA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail, fought back on the second turn and also weakened in the stretch.
