Footnotes

DONATO sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, drew off in the stretch along the inside under a tap of the whip and a steady hand ride until the late stages. TRUENO stalked off the rail then outside a rival, was no match for the winner in the stretch but held second. MATAMOR saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and put in a late bid at the place. BOBBY'S N PARADISE stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and weakened. VIVA MACHO pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside then off the rail, went outside a rival on the backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. WARRENS TEMPTATION close up stalking the winner along the inside, dropped back into and on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. CAPTAIN BEAU four wide into the first turn, chased outside then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and gave way. THUNDERCLAP NEWMAN also went four wide into the first turn, settled outside then off the rail and failed to menace. CALL THE RIVER broke a step slowly, pulled between horses then chased outside a rival, dropped back into the stretch and lacked a further response.
