Footnotes

LOS BOMBEROS had speed between horses then dueled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, inched away in the stretch, drifted out some in the final furlong but held under urging. CAT IN THE FOREST chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, swung out into the stretch and rallied willingly. EDGEWICK ROAD settled outside a rival chasing the pace, split horses into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and finished well. DELUXE BUS a bit slow into stride, settled just off the rail, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and put in a late bid. GIBSON HOME RUN dueled outside the winner, stalked in midstretch, drifted in late and was outfinished. CUT FASTBALL stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PREFERRED MANDATE sent along inside early, saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and weakened. ARRESTING OFFICER chased outside, dropped back three deep then off the rail on the turn and also weakened.
