Footnotes

ULTIMATE DECISION pulled between horses to gain the lead, inched away on the first turn, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, opened up under urging in midstretch and drew off. SIDEPOCKET KID a bit slow to begin, settled off the pace inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. PLEASANT SOUL had speed between foes then angled in on the first turn, stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and lost second late. CONFER saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOUTHERN SCULPTOR pulled his way along between horses then just off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MUCHO BRAVO chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside on the second turn and did not rally. ALL DE VICTORS between horses early, dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. ST. JOEL four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, dropped back leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. UNDAUNTED RALLY also went four wide into the first turn, chased outside then three deep to the stretch and also weakened. SPOOLTICS pulled his way along inside and steadied in tight on the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back between horses into the second turn and gave way. TINGALEO three deep on the first turn, settled outside or off the rail, drifted four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. YOU BETTER RUN four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
