Footnotes

REGALLY READY sped to the early lead outside a rival then kicked away and angled in on the first turn, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held sway under some urging with the whip turned down and an energetic hand ride. BIO PRO stalked outside a rival then off the rail into and on the second turn, loomed a threat behind the winner in the stretch, could not catch that one but was clearly second best. BOAT TRIP a bit slow to begin, chased off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, moved up outside a foe on the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and bested the others. LONGVIEW DRIVE saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MY BEST BROTHER stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. NO SILENT broke a bit slowly, angled in and stalked inside, fell back some on the second turn, gave way in the stretch and was eased in the final furlong.
