MONASTERY SCANDAL stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied gamely under a strong hand ride to gain the lead outside rivals in deep stretch and proved best. MADE THE FINALS had speed between foes then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but gamely held second. SKIMMETRY four wide early, stalked the pace of the rail then outside a rival leaving the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter in the stretch and between foes in deep stretch and bested the others. UNUSUAL TREASURE chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. MANDATE TO FLY angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRIAN THE BOLD settled outside a rival then off the rail leaving the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position. TIZMET saved ground off the pace, split rivals leaving the second turn, continued between horses in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ROYAL VISION chased outside a rival, split horses leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CUT TRAIL saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch and did not rally. PROUD 'N FABULOUS chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. CINDER CONE chased outside then four wide on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back on that bend and weakened.
