A. P. ADVENTURE broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, went up outside on the first turn then stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and rallied late under steady urging to collar the runner-up in deep stretch and won clear. SALTY ROMANCE sped to the early lead outside a rival, set the pace off the rail, opened up into the stretch, then drifted out and shortened stride late but held second. WILDWOOD FLOWER stalked the pace a just off the rail, came out a bit wide into the stretch, angled inward in deep stretch and could not catch the pacesetter but held third. STELLAR JAYNE chased outside a rival early then dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, moved up outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and was edged for the show. PENNY'S FORTUNE saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn, regained the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SUPER G I three deep into the first turn, angled in outside a rival, stalked between horses on the backstretch and inside on the second turn and weakened.
