

MASTER CHEF had speed between foes then stalked inside, came out and bid three deep leaving the turn, took the lead into the stretch and drew clear under urging. MEMPHIS bobbled at the start, chased between horses, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and was second best. SAMMY'S A RUNNIN' also bobbled slightly in a bit of a slow start, settled inside, moved up on the turn, waited off heels leaving the bend then went around a rival into the stretch, split horses a sixteenth out and gained the show. DERBY GOLD had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside a rival, battled on a short lead between foes a quarter mile out, fought back into the stretch, weakened some in the final furlong and was outfinished late for third. TRIBE chased off the rail then angled in on the turn, split rivals past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. SUN'S OUT squeezed a bit early, settled just off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. ISLAND SUNSET wide early, chased outside or alongside a rival, split foes into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. THREE VASES pulled between horses and was shuffled back some five eighths out, went outside on the turn and was forced out some midway on the bend, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. ALIZA'S DREAM chased outside a rival, steadied briefly when forced out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. ALIZA'S DREAM chased outside, was in a bit tight midway on the turn, continued four wide on the bend and into the stretch and weakened. PULPIT'S EXPRESS had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. TOUGH 'N DANGEROUS stalked early then bid three deep to duel for the lead, appeared to take a bad step then dropped back past midway on the turn, was pulled up and vanned off.
