Footnotes

LUNAR SURPRISE three deep into the first turn, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain the lead into the stretch and pulled clear under steady handling. MISS BANK ROBIN four wide into the first turn, angled in and set the pace along the inside, battled between horses into the stretch, then could not match the winner but gamely held second. VIRTUELESS WOMAN close up stalking the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, also could not match the winner and was outfinished for the place. UNDRRESSED came off the rail leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch but weakened. CASCADIA bobbled slightly just after the start, settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ALESSANDRIA pulled her way between horses early, chased outside a rival, also came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary response.
