TROPICAL BLOSSOM saved ground stalking the pace, swung out three deep into the stretch and wore down the runner-up late under urging. JEDDAH HARBOR three deep into the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the leader on the backstretch, took command leaving the second turn, kicked clear into the stretch and held on well but was caught late. STYLER hesitated then walked out of the gate to be off behind the field, raced a bit wide into the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. ROUWAKI allowed to settle out from the inside, also came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SECRET WILDCAT sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled inside the runner-up on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. DISTINCTIVE FLYER between horses early, was in a good position stalking outside the winner, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
