Footnotes

SPINELESSJELLYFISH saved ground stalking the pace, waited briefly off heels in upper stretch, split horses with a bid to gain the advantage past midstretch, drifted out a bit but held on gamely between foes under strong left handed urging. MACWARD chased off the rail down the hill, came out on the dirt and four wide into the stretch, bid outside past the eighth pole and continued willingly to the wire. TURKISH PRIZE raced unhurried a bit off the rail down the hill, came out in upper stretch and found his best stride late outside. SEA TO SEE went up inside to duel for command down the hill, inched away in midstretch, fought back when challenged again but weakened late. LENNYFROMALIBU stalked outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid between foes past midstretch but also weakened late. RIDE AND SHINE allowed to settle off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. GIBSON COUNTY sped to the early lead then dueled outside a rival, dropped back between horses in midstretch and had little left.
