Footnotes

OLD ED chased between foes then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn, gained the lead four wide into the stretch, drifted in and proved best under urging. PEACEFUL FLIGHT four wide into the first turn, chased outside, advanced four wide on the second turn, bid three deep leaving that turn, drifted to the inside in the stretch and was second best. EIGHT BELOW three deep on the first turn, chased outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn, steadied in tight into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and gained the show inside. SUNSET KID settled off the rail, moved up four wide leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and just missed third. PRINCELY GIFT saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. ZIELONKO angled in and stalked outside a rival, was between foes leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CITY VOW had good early speed and dueled between horses, battled between foes leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BILLY BALLADO saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn, came out in the stretch and had little left. DEREGULATION dueled inside, fought back on the second turn but gave way in the stretch and was eased late. BIG CASCADE prompted the pace three deep, dropped back on the second turn, also gave way and was eased in the stretch.
