GOLDENCENTS pulled and was in a bit tight off heels early, stalked just off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch, took the lead three deep nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best under urging. DEN'S LEGACY broke out a bit, stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail in deep stretch and edged a rival for the place. MANANDO sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, was between foes a sixteenth out and was edged for second. DRY SUMMER squeezed back some just after the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail to the stretch and gave way. DIRTY SWAGG chased outside a rival or off the rail, dropped back and angled in on the second turn, also gave way and was eased late.
