Footnotes

SHINE'N TIME had speed wide early then angled in and dueled outside a rival, inched away on the turn, kicked clear under urging in the stretch, drifted in some and proved best. MELBISHA chased inside, came out into the stretch, angled back in and gained the place. SHESKEY saved ground off the pace, moved up into the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and bested the others. WARREN'S SKATER broke out a bit, chased just off the rail or between foes, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MUM'S ZIP was in a good position stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WHYPRINCESSWHY chased between horses then outside, went three deep on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. I CAN YODEL TOO pulled her way along to stalk the pace just off the rail, came

out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. PRESS THE POINT unhurried a bit off the rail early, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. PAY THE GRAY broke in a bit, stalked off the rail then four wide, went three deep into and on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. TONKA T. dropped back between horses then outside, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. NINE RAILS had speed between horses then dueled inside the winner, stalked and angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. EVENTFUL MISS broke a bit slowly and was squeezed back, angled in and settled off the pace, came out into the stretch and was outrun.
