**Footnotes**

HEY YUP stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch, gained a slim advantage in midstretch and inched away late under urging. ALWAYS THE SAME sent along toward the inside early, dueled from the rail, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. MARY'S APP broke slowly, settled inside, saved ground on the turn, moved up along the rail into and through the stretch and picked up the show. MR. NEWTON sent between horses early, dueled outside the runner-up then stalked just off the rail, bid between rivals on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BERTRANDO GRANDE bobbled slightly at the start, settled outside then off the rail, drifted inward in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DONNOTAURUS hopped a bit in a slow start, went up inside to stalk the pace, came off the rail leaving the turn, angled out into the stretch and weakened. SKY LARKIN stalked the pace outside then three and four wide to the stretch and also weakened. THIEF RIVER broke out a bit, pulled his way along a bit off the rail then between horses, fell back some on the turn and also weakened. WHATS A REBAH steadied when squeezed at the start, settled outside a

rival then just off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and was not a threat. TROPILUK broke through the gate before the start, chased between horses early, dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
