E Z WARRIOR had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and proved best under a moderate hand ride. HURRY UP AUSTIN chased along the inside throughout and edged a rival for second. NOBLE COURT four wide early, stalked outside, came four wide into the stretch and bested the others. DESERT CODE forced the pace three deep on the backstretch and turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. COLONEL CHICK dueled between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, dropped back into the stretch, came out in the lane and also weakened. THE IVAN SHOW settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn, came out a bit in the stretch and failed to menace.
