Footnotes

EUROGLIDE prominently placed from the outside, continued on three wide path down the hill, moved up and bid outside pacesetter, battled in drive then inched away late under strong handling. KRUGER PARK quickly stepped to the front, dictated the pace from the inside into the lane, dug in when challenged, fought gamely inside but was outfinished. BAND OF THUNDER forced the pace while inside the winner, lost contact leaving the hill and finished evenly from the inside. MEDZENDEEKRON was off tardily and bit inward, chased from off the rail, advanced approaching the stretch, loomed four wide and outside the winner into the lane but failed to sustain effort. GOLDSVILLE unhurried while shifting inward, saved ground to the stretch and lacked any response from the inside. TALK OF A CAT settled off the pace and off the rail, chased three wide down the hill, came in some leaving the hill then shifted back out and failed to menace. Rail on the hill at 7 feet.
