Footnotes

VEILED MEETING pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out from between foes midway on the second turn, entered the stretch three deep, gained the lead in upper stretch and held gamely under urging, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. NIAGARA CAUSEWAY three deep on the first turn, dropped back outside on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, came out in the drive and just got the place. SOUND OF SUCCESS unhurried off the rail early, moved up outside on the second turn, was forced out and steadied midway on that bend, came five wide into the stretch, bid outside the winner, could not match that one late and just lost the place. REMEMBER ME angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked just off the rail leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. INDY WILDCAT angled in and chased outside a rival, continued three deep into the second turn, was forced out midway on that bend, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. IDENTIQUE angled in and chased outside a rival, was three deep on the second turn then forced out midway on that turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. RES IPSA chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, was in tight between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. OVERLAND TRAIL close up stalking the pace inside, waited a bit off heels in midstretch and weakened. EBONY LIGHT had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the second turn but weakened in the stretch. T. H. PRAISE pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. TUGGLES OF WAR chased between horses then outside a rival and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the second turn run between the first and third finishers but made no change when they ruled the incident was not sufficient to warrant a disqualification.
