Footnotes

SELF INSURED had speed outside rivals then stalked between foes, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid four wide under left handed urging in midstretch, gained the lead, drifted in some but won clear. STREETS OF HEAVEN stalked the pace outside, went between horses leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid between rivals in midstretch, could not match the winner but was second best. SPOT THE DIPLOMAT chased inside, was blocked off heels leaving the turn and until midstretch, came out past the eighth pole and picked up the show. PROFESSNL COURTESY had good early speed off the rail, inched away on the backstretch then dueled outside a foe, was between rivals in midstretch and weakened late. JOURNEYMAN broke a bit slowly, was taken off the rail then chased a bit off the fence, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RAINGEAR moved up between horses early then dueled inside, briefly put a head in front leaving the turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. STAND TALL allowed to settle outside then off the rail, came out a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally.
