TURKISH VICTORY went up inside to duel for the lead, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back under steady urging and held on gamely. DORIPRIZE (ARG) chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals in the drive, went four wide in deep stretch and edged a rival for

the place. LITTLE BRO stalked between horses, bid between rivals on the turn and into the stretch, battled outside the winner then between foes again in deep stretch and continued willingly. LEGENDARY MUD stalked between rivals on the backstretch and turn, split horses nearing midstretch and continued willingly inside. SO BEHOLD had speed outside then dueled three deep, battled four wide on the turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. SWISS SKI chased outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. STORMY GAME chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and also could not quite offer the needed response late. SAINT CHOCOLATE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. FRANKELSTEIN a bit slow to begin, pulled his way up to stalk the pace inside to the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. WARRENS FLYIN HIGH had good early speed and dueled between foes, was fanned four wide into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in upper stretch and also weakened. HELM'S PRESS chased between horses then outside, fell back some on the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and weakened. DELUXE CAT stalked outside then four wide on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in some and had little left in the drive.
