Footnotes

TURN ON THE BRITES chased on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, waited behind a wall of horses leaving the quarter pole, came out for room in upper stretch, steadied then angled inside the pacesetter in midstretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and held gamely. CONGREGATIONALIST dueled for the lead on the outside down the backstretch, stalked between horses on the turn, battled three deep in midstretch, took a short advantage past midstretch and battled outside the winner to the wire. FIGHTING ON angled to the outside on the backstretch, chased inside a rival into the turn, came into the lane four wide, bid four deep in midstretch, and held the show. BROKER BRETT chased outside a rival into the turn, came into the stretch four deep, remained four wide in midstretch and did not rally in the final furlong. LUCKY COTTON dueled for the lead inside a rival down the backstretch, inched away on the turn, drifted out from the whip but maintained a short advantage in midstretch and weakened between horses in the late going. CINCO DE MARIO chased off the rail on the backstretch and three wide around the turn, came into the stretch three deep and weakened between horses in the final furlong.
