Footnotes

CHASTER lagged back off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied while lugging in under left handed urging to prove narrowly best. PARIS ORBIT settled off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, split horses into the second turn, waited a bit off heels leaving that turn, angled inward with a move forward into the stretch, bid between horses past midstretch and continued willingly between foes to the wire. RECKLESSWARRANT four wide into the first turn, angled in leaving that bend and saved ground, went up along the rail to gain the lead on the second turn, inched away, fought back when challenged and also went gamely to the end. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER sent along to duel outside a rival, continued three deep into the stretch, then weakened and had the rider lose the whip in deep stretch. ELEVATOR GAIL angled in unhurried just off the inside early, made up some ground on the second turn and in the stretch but was not a threat. LIGHT UP THE YEAR had good early speed and duelled inside a rival, came out a bit leaving the second turn and weakened. SUPERGET chased the dueling leaders off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and also weakened.
