Footnotes

PARLIAMENTARIAN pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, split horses on the turn, bid alongside a rival leaving the bend, took a short lead in the stretch, inched away in midstretch and drew clear under some urging and a strong hand ride. RUSSEL'S RUN chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled in some leaving the turn, split foes into the stretch and was clearly second best. VALLEY OF KINGS had speed between horses to press the pace, took a short lead outside a rival on the turn, angled in, battled inside the winner leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. JOE HARDOON broke in and a bit slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. M TWO FORTY stalked outside then four wide leaving the backstretch and three deep on the turn and weakened. HI CHOOCH sped to the early lead, dueled inside, stalked along the rail leaving the turn and also weakened. AWESOME KITE broke slowly, moved up to stalk between horses, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
