TRIBAL GAL had good early speed between horses then set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in and inched away on the turn, kicked clear and held under urging. AWESOME ANNIE saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail in upper stretch and was clearly second best. FUNNY GAL also saved ground chasing the winner, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and edged a rival late for the show. TRIBAL CUSTOM was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and was edged late for third. BERT'S ALTARCATION broke inward and a bit awkwardly, was between horses early then dropped back off the rail, came out on the turn, was three wide into the stretch and bested the others. PINE WALK chased just off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ECONOMY OF MOTION had speed off the rail then stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. WINK AND WISH broke a bit slowly, chased outside a rival, dropped back and angled in leaving the turn and gave way.
