Footnotes

PETER AND ZOE prompted the pace inside then outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. VICTORY SIGN chased inside, came out in upper stretch and again in midstretch and finished well but drifted in and bumped a rival late. BRANSFIELD four wide early, stalked outside a rival, ranged up three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner, could not match that one late, was bumped and steadied in late stretch and held third. A BIG TO'DO angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and steadied in tight off heels late. SPECIAL INTEREST was in a good position chasing the pace between horses, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ON EDGE angled in and settled inside then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ECRU EGRET close up stalking the pace inside, awaited room leaving the second turn, split horses in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ATOZOE chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch and also could not summon the necessary response. NEXT GENERATION unhurried outside a rival for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and did not rally. WILDFANG broke slowly, angled in and saved ground and was outrun. SILVER KNOCKOUT between horses early, dueled outside the winner, inched away and angled in entering the backstretch, dueled inside that one to the stretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the late stretch run of the runner-up but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
