KING OF THE GREEN settled along the rail, moved up from the inside, then angled out, chased three wide into the lane, rallied then bid from between rivals in deep stretch and got up on the wire. PRIZE PLAY stumbled leaving the gate then quickly recovered, stalked from along the rail, moved up, challenged outside pacesetter into the lane, gained lead, dug in from the inside but was nailed on the wire. BLASTERMAN settled inside, chased inside then two wide, shifted out exiting the final turn, came out further in upper stretch, rallied strongly from the far outside and narrowly missed. B'S LUCKY STRIKE bumped at the start, quickly crossed over, also saved ground into second turn, shifted out, raced four wide into the lane, rallied outside winner and narrowly missed three deep at the finish. A BIG TO'DO saved ground chasing the pace throughout and finished evenly. JOB BOSS broke out and bumped rival, angled over, prompted the early pace, stalked two wide and later weakened. FIGEAC was washy going to the gate, sent to the front, rank and lugged out around the initial turn, came back in, set the pace into the second turn, lost control and gave way. . CUT chased outside rival, dropped back around the final turn and gave way readily.
