Footnotes

OSCILLATOR pulled and steadied when in tight between horses leaving the five eighths marker, chased between foes then a bit off the rail, angled in entering the turn, came out to enter the stretch three wide, rallied three deep through the lane, took over leaving the sixteenth marker and held for the score. SWEET NECTAR angled in leaving the chute, stalked a bit off the rail down the backstretch, saved some ground around the turn, came out at the quarter pole to bid for the lead, took a short lead in midstretch, was run down late but was clearly second best. ONE FAST FROG moved up between horses to take the early lead, set the pace off the rail down the backstretch and inside around the turn, was challenged for command at the quarter pole, fought back in upper stretch then weakened on the inside in the final furlong. CUVEE EXCHANGE chased the pace three deep down the backstretch, remained off the wood in the lane and failed to rally. BRITENESS stalked the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane four wide and weakened in the final furlong. MISSDANG SALLY pulled a bit early, chased on the inside throughout, fell back some on the turn, gave way and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
