THE WHOLE DEAL broke out a bit, stalked inside then bid between horses leaving the backstretch, dueled outside a rival on the turn, inched away into the stretch and drew clear under urging. HE'S NOT TOO SHABY broke a bit awkwardly and was squeezed back, pulled his way along inside to move up then was in a bit tight off heels into the turn and again midway on the bend, came out into the stretch, lugged inward in the drive but picked up the place. HUNGER chased between foes early then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and edged a rival late for third. SACRED OVATION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. DERRINGER stalked early then bid three deep leaving the backstretch, tracked the leaders outside the runner-up on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. CARIBOO ROAD chased outside a rival then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn and also weakened. SHOER HUGH settled outside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat.
