**Footnotes**

FLY HIGH sent between foes to press the pace then stalked a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, rallied while drifting out under left handed urging to get up late. OLD PUEBLO had speed four wide then stalked leaving the backstretch, bid alongside a rival on the turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, inched away past midstretch but could not hold off the winner. ANZEAU chased outside then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some but edged a rival late for the show. HIGH ON FINAL duelled inside then inched away on the backstretch, battled inside the runner-up on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SPECTACULARJOURNEY broke out a bit, chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STARRY SHARK had speed three deep between foes then pulled some and steadied when squeezed a half mile out, fell back between foes on the turn, came around a rival into the stretch and weakened. SATCH angled in and chased inside, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response. EL MAGICO a bit crowded at the start, settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. MIXED NUTS wide early, angled in and settled just off the inside on the backstretch and turn and failed to menace. EL NERON between horses early, dropped back off the rail and was always outrun.
