### Footnotes

MIDNIGHT HAWK had speed three deep then dueled outside the runner-up, took a short lead on the backstretch, regained the advantage into the stretch, inched away nearing midstretch, drifted in but won clear under left handed urging. KRISTO sped to the early lead, dueled inside the winner, put a head back in front into the second turn, fought back into the stretch, came off the rail past midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but continued willingly late. ONTOLOGY bobbled a bit at the start, was between horses early then stalked outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and could make no further impact. I'LL WRAP IT UP pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, fell back on the second turn and weakened.
