Footnotes

HOME RUN KITTEN a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain the lead in upper stretch and held on gamely under urging. FOOTSTEPSINBRONZE (IRE) sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled outside a rival, battled between foes leaving the hill and three deep into the stretch, continued alongside the winner through the final furlong and went willingly to the wire. MELATONIN chased outside then fell back four

wide on the hill, came out six wide into the stretch and bested the others. FRIENDSWITH K MILL settled off the rail then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ARCTIC CODE went up inside to duel for the lead, battled along the rail down the hill, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. DISTILLERY pulled between horses then chased four wide on the hill and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. SUDDEN RUMOR bobbed at the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again nearing the stretch and did not rally. CRONUT broke a bit slowly, settled outside then angled in a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, was in tight off heels past midstretch and was not a threat. PYROTECHNICS stalked between horses, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted out a bit past midstretch and weakened. WYNHURST pulled between horses and was in a bit tight early, continued a bit off the rail leaving the hill, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. RELATIVE TIME stalked the pace three deep then bid three wide leaving the hill, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in then out in the drive and weakened. WICKED HEAT broke a bit slowly, pulled between horses to chase the pace down the hill and weakened in the stretch. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
